Claim to property (portion) of the estate of George Malone, Sr. decd. left his son George Jr. of Giles County, Tennessee, Deed Book 12-Page 148, Brunswick County, Virginia, is a marriage contract dated and recorded 25 January 1777 between George Malone, Sr. of Brunswick County, Virginia and LUCY CARTER , widow of relict GEORGE CARTER decd. In Deed Book 9 page 586 - February 24, 1770 is recorded a deed from John Mitchell of Brunswick County, Virginia to daughter LUCY CARTER
