

Donald "Don" L. Anderson, 53, died Tuesday, Feb. 19, 2008, in Clayton.

He was born Dec. 8, 1954, to Dr. Karl "Andy" Anderson and Elizabeth "Lib" Anderson. He attended Rabun Gap-Nacoochee School. He was a jockey, horse trainer and musician. He rode thoroughbreds at many tracks in the U.S. As a trainer, he had horses at tracks primarily in the northeastern U.S. He enjoyed playing the guitar and had made a number of recordings in recent years. He recently worked at the FAITH Thrift Store in Clayton.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Elizabeth "Lib" Anderson, on July 7, 2006.

Survivors include: his father, Karl "Andy" Anderson of Clayton; and a sister, Karen Cooper of Bradenton, Fla.
