

### Child Dies On Way To Franklin Hospital

Funeral services for Frances Anderson, the eight-months-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Thurman Anderson, of Tellico and Gastonia, were held on Saturday afternoon at 3 o'clock at the Oak Grove Baptist church. The Rev. A. J. Smith, of Tellico, officiated. Burial was in the church cemetery.

Mr. and Mrs. Anderson were en route to a Franklin hospital from Gastonia when suddenly the child died on the way. A few days prior to its death it was severely burned on its chest by pulling hot coffee off the table. It died Friday night.

Surviving besides the parents are one small sister, the grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Roy Jenkins, of Franklin, route 4, and the grandmother, Mrs. James A. Anderson, of Tellico.
