

## Funeral For Henry Anderson Held Saturday

Funeral services for Henry Millas Anderson, 69, were held at the Malden's Chapel Methodist church on Cartoogechaye on Saturday morning at 10 o'clock. The Rev. E. P. Davenport, pastor of the Church of God on Cartoogechaye, officiated, assisted by the Rev. Howard Speed. Interment was in the church cemetery.

Mr. Anderson, a farmer of the Cartoogechaye community, died at his home on Thursday evening at 10:15, following a lingering illness of one year, although he had been critically ill for the past month.

Born on May 1, 1877, Mr. Anderson was the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Robert Anderson, of the Cartoogechaye section. He had lived in Macon county practically all his life, and was married to Miss Minnie Mae Fair who preceded him in death one month ago. He was a member of the Malden's Chapel Methodist church.
