

Mike C. Anderson Funeral Service Conducted Sunday

Funeral services for Mike C. Anderson, 66-year old farmer, were held Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock at the Tellico Baptist church, with the Rev. Norman E. Holden, Baptist minister of the West's Mill community, officiating. Burial followed in the church cemetery.

The pallbearers were Harley Mason, John Anderson, Clyde Morgan, Ervin Smith, Wint DeHart and Carl Morgan.

Mr. Anderson died at the home of his son, Verlon Anderson, on the Franklin-Highlands highway on Saturday morning at 7:30 o'clock from a heart attack, although he had been in ill health for a year.

A life-long resident of Macon county, Mr. Anderson was born on March 11, 1879, in the Tellico community, where he had lived most of his life. He was the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. John Anderson. He was married to Miss Lavada Mason, who survives. He was a member of the Tellico Baptist church.
