

Mrs. Anderson Passes Sunday on Cartoogechaye

Funeral services for Mrs. Minnie Fair Anderson, 66, were held on Monday afternoon at 3 o'clock at the Maiden Chapel Methodist church on Upper Cartoogechaye. The Rev. Elmer Daveport, pastor of the Church of God, of Cartoogechaye, officiated and interment was in the church cemetery.

Mrs. Anderson died at her home on Cartoogechaye on Sunday morning at 3 o'clock very unexpectedly from a heart attack, although she had not been well for the past two weeks.

Mrs. Anderson, who was the former Miss Minnie Fair, was born in Cherokee county on February 2, 1874. She was the daughter of the late Turner and Caroline Abernathy Fair. Following her marriage to Henry Anderson, she has made her home on Cartoogechaye for the past 40 years. She was a member of the Maiden Chapel Methodist church.
