

# MRS. ANDERSON DIES MARCH 6 AT SON'S HOME

**Macon Native Was  
76; Services Held  
8th At Tellico**

Mrs. Vada Mason Anderson, widow of Michael C. Anderson, died March 6 at 3:45 p. m. at the home of a son, Lyle Anderson, of Franklin, Route 4. Seventy-six years old, she had been ill for two years.
