Dies In Utah Accident On 35th Birthday

Word has been received here of the death of Fitzhugh L. Ashe, of Salt Lake City, Utah. Mr. Ashe, who was the grandson of Mr. Lee Bernard, Sr., of Franklin, was killed in an automobile accident in Utah Wednesday of last week—on his 35th birthday.

The son of Mrs. Claude Sevier, of Ridgefield, Wash., formerly Miss Beeler Barnard, of Franklin, Mr. Ashe often has visited here, having been in Franklin the last time while he was in service, during World War 2.

An employe of the Western Wax Paper company, Mr. Ashe was well known in golfing circles in Portland, Ore., where he made his home until he moved to Salt Lake City last year.

Survivors include his widow and two small children, Karlyn Christine and Mindy Lee.

Funeral services were held Monday in Portland.
