

Vernon A. Baldwin

Vernon A. Baldwin, 60, a resident of Detroit, Mich., since 1949, died unexpectedly of an apparent heart attack Wednesday, January 9, in Detroit. A native of Macon County, he was the son of Harley E. and the late Althea Humphries Baldwin and was married to Marie Hastings, who survives.

He was a member of the First Baptist Church in Franklin and was employed by Lyons, Inc., of Detroit, as a mechanic. He was a veteran of World War II.
