

"Bob" Barnett Dies At Home Near Aquone

Robert L. Barnett, 52, prominent farmer of the Aquone section, died at 8 o'clock Monday morning at his home after an illness of several months.

The body was taken to Bull Creek cemetery, near Mars Hill in Madison county, for burial. Mr. Barnett formerly lived in Madison county. Surviving are his widow and several brothers.

Mr. Barnett, known to many simply as "Bob" Barnett, had a wide circle of friends. He had the reputation of being a good fisherman and guide and sportsmen frequently visited his home in the Aquone section.
