

Memorial Services For Pfc. James H. Baty

Memorial services for Pfc. H. Baty, 30, son of Mr. and Mrs. Henry J. Baty, are planned for Sunday, October 14, at Highlands Baptist church. Pfc. Baty's death was confirmed last week in a telegram from the War Department as having occurred on May 8, 1942. He had previously been reported missing in action about that time. He enlisted in the chemical air corps in February, 1940, the second of seven brothers to enlist in the service.

Pfc. Homer Baty of the Infantry was the first to enlist, and has recently received an honorable discharge. The other five brothers in the service are Ronald and John William of the marines; Clarence of the navy, Jack in the air corps, and Joe with the army of occupation in Germany. The survivors include also two younger brothers, Herbert and Earl Baty.
