

## Parker Berry, 50 Dies In Fort Worth

News has been received here of the death of Parker Berry, 50, who died at his home in Fort Worth, Texas, on Wednesday, May 4.

Mr. Berry, a native of Macon county, and a son of the late Parker and Lilly Penland Berry, left this county about 28 years ago, and since 1919 has been a finance company operator in Fort Worth.

Mr. Berry has a large connection throughout Macon county. He was a veteran of the World War, a member of the Masonic Order and a Shriner.

Besides several uncles, aunts and other close relatives here, he is survived by his widow and two daughters, Misses Virginia and Anne Berry, and a brother, Louie Berry, all of Fort Worth.

Funeral services were held on Friday, May 6, at the Magnolia Avenue Christian church in Fort Worth, and interment was in Mount Olive cemetery in that city.
