

# GIRL LOSES LIFE IN LAKE EMORY

## Little Dorothy Mae Bingham Drowns In Lake Emory

Little Dorothy Mae Bingham, five-year-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Carl Bingham, was drowned in Lake Emory at the municipal power dam on Wednesday afternoon when she fell into 20 feet of water.

Her father, care taker of the power plant, exhausted himself in efforts to dive to sufficient depth to rescue the girl. Help was summoned from Franklin, and Will Moore, cashier of the Citizens Bank, brought the body to the surface. The little girl had been in the water about 25 minutes and efforts to resuscitate her were unavailing.
