Macon Native Dies
May 23; Services
Held In Franklin

Mrs. Lula Rosetta Blaine Bingham, native of this county and wife of John R. Bingham, died May 23 at 7:05 p. m. at her home. Eighty-two years old, she had been ill for two months.
