### Succumbs To Long Illness At His Otto Home

Claude Bradley, 50, died at his home in the Otto community Wednesday afternoon of last week at 1:30 o'clock, following a year's illness.

Funeral services were held on Thursday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the Asbury Methodist church, with the Rev. V. N. Allen, pastor, officiating. Interment followed in the church cemetery.
