Former Teacher, Dies At Oak Grove

D. L. Bradley, 62-year old farmer and former teacher, died at his home in the Oak Grove community at 2 o'clock Monday afternoon, following an illness of three years.

A native of this county, he taught in the Macon County schools, and served as superintendent of the Oak Grove Baptist Sunday school until ill health interfered.
