

Last Rites Held For Marcus Bradley, 63

Funeral services for Marcus Sylvester Bradley, 63, were held on Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock at the Dillard, Ga. Methodist church. The Rev. Jack Waldroop, pastor, officiated, assisted by the Rev. Lester Sorrells, Baptist minister of Macon county. Interment followed in the Dillard cemetery.

Mr. Bradley died at his home in the Upper Cartoogechaye community on Friday night following a serious illness of one week, although he had been in ill health for several weeks.
