### Services Held Friday For Robert Brooks

Funeral services for Robert (Bob) Brooks, 35, were held at the Bethel Methodist church on the Franklin-Highlands highway last Friday morning at 11 o'clock. The Rev. Harry S. Williams, pastor, was in charge. Interment was in the church cemetery.

Mr. Brooks, who had been working at New Paltz, N. Y., for about five years, was killed in an accident Wednesday, August 30, at 12:30 o'clock p. m., when the car in which he was riding collided with another car. The body was brought to the home of the parents on Franklin Route 4, Thursday.

Born in Jackson county on July 30, 1904, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Cole Brooks, now of Franklin Route 4, he lived most of his life in Macon county. In January, 1930, he married Miss Margaret Godfrey, of West Point, Ga.
