

Brother Of Mrs. Thorpe Dies In Chattanooga

Foster ~~B.~~ Brown, 53, World War I hero, who served 23 years in the army, died July 8 at the Veteran hospital in Murfreesboro, Tenn.

Lt. Brown won the French Croix-de-Guerre in World War I.

The funeral was held at his home in Chattanooga, with the Rev. Stephen C. Walke of St. Paul's Episcopal church officiating. The burial was held with full military honors in the Forest Hill cemetery.

He is the brother of Mrs. J. E. S. Thorpe of Franklin.
