

Z. D. Buchanan Passes At Oak Ridge Home

Z. Dee Buchanan died at his home in the Oak Ridge community on Wednesday, July 19, following an illness of several months.

Mr. Buchanan, a well-known farmer of Macon county, was born in Little Rock, Ark., in 1860, and moved to this county when quite young. In 1880 he was married to Miss Tabitha Moore. He was a member of the Ridgecrest Baptist church and was a man who will be greatly missed in his community.

Funeral services were held at the Ridgecrest Baptist church on Thursday afternoon with the Rev. C. C. Welch, pastor, assisted by the Rev. W. L. Bradley, of Etna, and the Rev. Mr. Rogers, of Haywood county.
