Sgt. Lewis B. Bule, husband of Mrs. Pauline Bule, was killed August 8 in the Azores.

Sgt. Bule is a native of Broadway, N. C., and is a graduate of the Boone Trail high school. After his graduation he was with the Forest Service in Asheville, and was transferred to Franklin five years ago where he was employed at the Cowee experiment station.

Sgt. Bule married Miss Pauline Welch, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Floyd Welch of Franklin, July 20, 1941.

Sgt. Bule entered the service March 24 1943. He received his training at the following places: basic at St. Petersburg, Fla.; radio training at Scott Field, Ill., gunnery school at Tynall Field, Fla.; and advanced flying at Westover Field, Mass.

Sgt. Bule was a radio operator gunner on a B-24 Liberator and went overseas about Aug. 1, 1944.
