

Sgt. Bumgarner's Rites To Be Held Sunday In Swain

Funeral services for B. Sgt. James Berlin Bumgarner, brother of Mrs. Oscar C. Bryant and Miss Frankie Bumgarner, of Franklin, will be held at the home of Sgt. Bumgarner's mother, Mrs. H. C. Bumgarner, of Whittier, Route 1, Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock.

The Rev. John Hyatt, pastor of the Wilmot Baptist church, assisted by the Rev. Henry Cochran, of Alarka, and the Rev. C. E. Parker, of Franklin, will conduct the service, and the American Legion will be in charge of the graveside rites in the family cemetery.

Sgt. Bumgarner, who entered service in December, 1942, and went overseas in August, 1944, died February 20, 1945 of wounds. He was 32 years of age.
