

C. R. Cabe, Former County Commissioner, Dies At 78

Charles Robert Cabe, 78, retired farmer and former county commissioner, died last Thursday at his Otto home after an illness of six months.

A native of this county, he served 12 years on the board of county commissioners, eight as a member and four as chairman, from 1924 to 1928. He also served for a period as county accountant while on the board.

Funeral services for Mr. Cabe were conducted Monday at 2:30 p. m. at the Asbury Methodist Church by the Rev. R. L. Poindexter. Burial was in the church cemetery.

The son of Z. P. and Mrs. Mary Ann Mann Cabe, he was born May 29, 1877. On September 29, 1897, he was married to Miss Martha Lou Campbell, who survives. Mr. Cabe was a member of the Junior Order of United American Mechanics.

Other survivors include two sons, Claude and Neville Cabe, of Otto; four daughters, Mrs. Ralph Norton, of Otto, Mrs. Vance Rogers, of Darrington, Wash., Mrs. Charles M. Rogers and Mrs. Ted Blaine, both of Franklin; a brother, John E. Cabe, of Otto; 14 grandchildren; and one great-grandchild.
