Services for Spec. 4 Dennis Stewart Cabe, 21, son of Mr. and Mrs. Norman G. Cabe of Dillard, Ga., Rt. 1, who died in Vietnam July 22, were held at 2:30 p.m. Sunday in Morrison's Presbyterian Church, of which he was a member.

A detachment from Fort McPherson, Ga., conducted full military rites and served as pallbearers.

Spec. Cabe was a graduate of Franklin High School in 1966. He entered the service March 12, 1967.

Armed Forces in Germany and Michael and Handy Cabe, both of the home; two sisters, Reba and Carole Cabe, both of the home; the paternal grandparents, Annis and Minnie Cabe and the maternal grandparents, John and Vinie Hasket, all of Franklin.

The body remained at Neal and Potts Funeral Home, where the family received friends from 7 to 9 p.m. Saturday, and was placed in the church 30 minutes prior to the services.
