

## John E. Cabe

"Mr. Johnny" Cabe, 89 year old resident of the Otto

Community died last Thursday at his home following an illness of three years.

Born in Macon County January 2, 1880, he had been a leader in community and church affairs in the Smithbridge Township since early manhood. In particular, throughout his life he had worked for the betterment of public education and had served as a member of the County Board of Education for several years.

A member of the Asbury United Methodist Church, he had served as a trustee and member of the board of stewards.

Mr. Cabe first married Miss Nora Campbell, who died in 1917. He later married Miss Minnie Norris, who died in 1964.

Funeral services were held at his home church with Rev. Clifford Clubb, pastor, conducting the service.
