

MRS. CABE DIES IN MORGANTON

Rites For Macon Native Held Friday At Clark's Chapel

Mrs. Margaret Rosalind Moore Cabe, a native of Macon County, died Wednesday of last week in Morganton after an illness of six years. She was 56 years old.

Funeral services were conducted Friday morning at 11 o'clock at the Clark's Chapel Methodist church by the Rev. J. D. Pyatt, pastor, and the Rev. C. E. Murray, pastor of the Franklin Methodist church. Burial was in the church cemetery.
