

Mrs. Sarah Cabe Dies At Age 89

Mrs. Sarah Elizabeth (Odie) Cabe, a native of this county, died Monday in a local hospital. Eighty-nine years old, she had been in declining health for some time.

Funeral services were conducted Tuesday at 11 a. m. at the Clark's Chapel Methodist Church, of which she was a member. Officiating were the Rev. R. L. Poindexter, pastor, and the Rev. S. B. Moss, pastor of the First Methodist Church. Burial was in the church cemetery.
