

## Last Rites For E. K. Campbell

Eugene K. Campbell, Sr., died at his home in Decatur, Ga., on January 25, following an illness of four years. He was the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. George Campbell, life-long residents of Franklin, and had been a railway agent in Atlanta for a number of years, until illness forced his retirement two years ago.
