

Mrs. Carden Rites Held On Saturday

Funeral services for Mrs. Nancy "Aunt Nancy" Carden, who died Tuesday of last week at the age of 90 at her home in the Liberty section, were conducted Saturday at 10 a.m. at the Liberty Baptist Church.

Officiating were the Rev. Judd Duvall, pastor, the Rev. George A. Cloer, and the Rev. Norman E. Holden. Burial was in the church cemetery.
