

Plunges To Death Over Waterfall

Miss Martha Sue Carlin, popular 18-year-old Brenau college student, plunged to her death over a 150-foot waterfall during a picnic outing last Thursday, it has been learned here. She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. P. J. Carlin, of Miami, who have owned a summer home in Highlands for many years.

Miss Carlin was wading with other students in a stream above Glade Shoals, in the North Georgia mountains 12 miles from Gainesville, when she slipped and fell down the sheer granite wall which carries the cascade. An ambulance crew lifted her body from the pool below the falls about a half hour later. She had apparently died instantly from a broken neck, it is reported.

In addition to her parents she is survived by two brothers, Robert, a student at the University of Florida, and James, of the U. S. Navy.
