

Minister Dies

Rev. Frederick Cochrane's Body Brought Home

Funeral services for the Rev. Frederick Cochrane, who died in Lake City, Fla., Sunday morning, were held in Asheville Tuesday morning and the body was brought to Briartown, his old home place in this county, for burial.

The deceased was a Baptist minister and a former patient at the U. S. Veterans' hospital at Oteen. He served as chaplain during the World War for that institution. He was a graduate of the University of North Carolina and Crozier Theological Seminary of Chester, Pa. He held pastorates in Philadelphia, Texas and North Carolina.

The deceased was born and reared in the Briartown section and was well known in Macon county. He is the son of S. M. Cochrane. Besides his father, he is survived by his widow and five children, of Asheville.
