

Highlands Man Killed Monday In South Carolina

James F. Cole, a Highlands construction worker, was shot to death by his father-in-law Monday at Traveler's Rest, S. C., during a family argument, it has been learned here.

Samuel C. Arrowood, a 66-year-old farmer, is understood to have surrendered to police and admitted the slaying.

Cole was fatally wounded by a blast from a .12 gauge shotgun during an argument with his father-in-law and wife. Arrowood is reported to have told officers that Cole threatened to cut his throat.
