
Pyt. Fred Crane Killed In Action

Private Fred Crane, son of Mrs. Olive Crane and the late Ed Crane of Highlands, has been reported killed in action in France on July 20th, according to a telegram from the War Department to his wife, Mrs. Thelma Goff Crane of Blaney, S. C. Private Crane was twenty-five years old. He entered the service four years ago and had been overseas with the Thirteenth Infantry division since last November. He has two brothers in the service, Thad Crane, with the infantry in France and James Crane with the air corps in California. In addition to his wife he leaves two small children.

His sisters are Mrs. Robert Bell, Mrs. J. A. Davis, Jr., the Misses Etta, Edna and Hazel Crane, and one brother, Floyd Crane, not in service.
