

Funeral Service For Crickenberger Is Conducted Here

Last rites for J. F. Crickenberger, Jr., were held at the Franklin Methodist church Sunday of last week at 4 p. m., with the Rev. L. B. Hayes and the Rev. Hoyt E. ... officiating. Burial was in the Franklin cemetery.

Mr. Crickenberger, 48, brother-in-law of Mrs. Ralph Womack, had been visiting Mr. and Mrs. Womack for several weeks, prior to going to Asheville to open a store he recently bought on the County Home road in Buncombe county. He went to Asheville on business April 29, was stricken with a heart attack, and died that night in an Asheville hospital. He had been
