

## Three Year Old Struck By Car

A three-year-old child, Jamie Loraine Crunkleton, was killed Monday morning when she stepped from behind one car and was struck by another vehicle.

The child and her aunt, Mrs. Robert Crunkleton waiting to be picked up to go to the Co-wee day care center where Mrs. Crunkleton works when the incident occurred.

State Highway Patrolman, W. G. Leming, who investigated the accident said the child darted into the path of a north bound car driven by Harold Hoffman, Jr., of Route 3, Franklin. Mr. Hoffman was on his way to Bryson City to serve as a court recorder.

The accident took place around 9 a.m. on NC 28 about 11 miles north of Franklin.

The small girl was pronounced dead on arrival at the Angel Community Hospital. She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. James Newton Crunkleton, of Knoxville, Tenn.

She is survived by her parents; one brother, Scott Crunkleton, of the home; the maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. George Johnson, of Knoxville; and the paternal grandmother, Mrs. Majorie Crunkleton Sutton, of Rabun Gap, Georgia.

The body was taken to Knoxville, Tenn., for burial.
