

Cunningham, Macon Native Dies In Georgia

George Perry Cunningham, Sr., a Franklin native and well-known Cornelia, Ga., druggist, died in the Habersham County (Ga.) Hospital Thursday, October 3, following an illness of several weeks. He was 63.

Mr. Cunningham moved to Cornelia in 1919. He was the son of the late George and Emma Jacobs Cunningham.

Funeral services were held in Cornelia on Friday.

The Franklin native was a member and a deacon of the First Baptist Church of Cornelia, past president of the Kiwanis Club, past master of the Cornelia Masonic Lodge 92, vice-president and director of the Cornelia Bank, and a director of the Habersham Federal Savings and Loan Association.
