

## One of Oldest Residents Of County Dies on Iotla

Mrs. Joanna Cunningham died at the home of her son, Frank, on Iotla Wednesday morning at 10 o'clock, after an illness of several months.

Funeral services were held at the Iotla Methodist church Thursday morning at 11 o'clock with the Rev. N. G. Dulin, pastor, assisted by the Rev. A. S. Solesbee, Baptist minister, conducting the final rites.
