Carl B. Curtis, 86, of Cumming, died Sunday, Nov. 9, 2003.

He was born July 5, 1917, in Rabun County to L.H. and Julia Curtis. He retired from the Georgia Power Company in 1986 after 43 years of service. The last 37 of those years were spent as manager in Cumming.

He served as chairman of the Forsyth County Hospital Board. He was a member and treasurer of the March of Dimes. He served more than 30 years on the Cumming Housing Authority, including many years as chairman. He was the past president of the Cumming Kiwanis Club and was a member and deacon of Cumming Baptist Church.

He was preceded in death by his son, Carl B. Curtis.
