Flats Resident, Dies - At Son's Home

James Robert Dalrymple, 67, a resident of the Flats section, died on Sunday afternoon about 6 o'clock at the home of his son, Doyle Dalrymple, in the Cartoogechaye community, following an illness of three months. Death was attributed to a heart ailment.

Mr. Dalrymple was reared in the Flats section, where he has lived all his life. He was a farmer and a member of the Briartown church. He married Miss Annie Cross, who died a few years ago.

Funeral services were held Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Franklin Grove Baptist church, near Bryson City, with the Rev. William Buchanan, officiating. Interment followed in the Watkins cemetery.
