Dies At Age Of 86 In
Dillsboro

Funeral services for Mrs. Laura Catherine Shuler Dalton, 85, of the Cowee community, who died last Thursday morning at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Leona Walker, of Dillsboro, following a brief illness, were held Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Liberty Baptist church.
