

**Charles C. Daniels
Claimed By Death
In New York At 86**

Charles Cleaves Daniels, Franklin summer resident, died at St. Luke's hospital, New York, Tuesday. He was 86.

Funeral services will be conducted at Wilson, his former home, this afternoon, and burial will follow in the family plot there.

A New York attorney for many years, Mr. Daniels began the practice of law in Franklin. Earlier he had edited the Kinston Free Press and the Wilson Advance, previously edited by his brother, Josephus Daniels.

In Wilson he served 12 years as solicitor, later served as county attorney for Grant county, Oklahoma, and during the Wilson administration was special assistant to the U. S. attorney general.

Survivors include his widow, the former Miss Mary Robinson, who was reared at "Dixie Hall" here; a daughter, Miss Hope Daniels; and a son, James Robinson Daniels, all of New York.
