

Mrs. A. Daves, Macon Native, Is Dead At 95

Funeral services for Mrs. Addie Daves, 95, who died in Commerce, Ga., Saturday, following a very brief illness, were held at the Burningtown Baptist church Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock. The Rev. George A. Cloer, pastor, officiated, and interment followed in the church cemetery.
