

Mrs. Alice D. Dills

Dies May 30 At Her Home
In Cartoogechaye

Mrs. Alice Davis Dills, 70, a resident of Macon County for 56 years, died last Wednesday morning, May 30, at her home in the Cartoogechaye community. She had been ill only a brief time.

Funeral services were held Thursday afternoon at 3 o'clock at the Cartoogechaye Baptist church with the Rev. Raleigh Guffey officiating. Burial was in the church cemetery.

Mrs. Dills was born February 20, 1881 in Buncombe County, the daughter of Ben and Elizabeth Payne Davis. She came to Macon County in 1895, and in 1898 was married to Tom Dills, who died several years ago.
