

DILLS DIES AT BURRELLS

**Mechanic And Veteran
Succumbs While At
Work On Car Sunday**

Chaille McCoy Dills, 38, mechanic and native of this county, died from a heart attack at noon Sunday while working on an automobile at Burrell Motor Company, Inc.

A hydramatic transmission specialist, he had worked for the motor company for the past 10 years. He lived on Franklin, Route 4, in the Windy Gap section.

Funeral services for Mr. Dills, a veteran of World War II, were conducted yesterday (Wednesday) afternoon at 2 o'clock, at the Sugarfork Baptist Church by the Rev. Jarvis Underwood, pastor.
