

Killed in Crash

Dorcian C. Dills Dies in Auto Accident

Dorcian C. Dills, 27, a filling station operator in West Canton, was almost instantly killed when the car he was driving overturned Tuesday night about 11 o'clock on the Jonathan creek road in Haywood county about 42 miles north of Waynesville. Mr. Dills formerly lived in the Cullasaja section of Macon county.

The funeral service was scheduled to be held in Franklin today.

Dills is survived by his widow, a small son and his mother, Mrs. James Ford.

Another Canton man was riding with Dills but escaped injury. Dills, who was pinned beneath the car, suffered a broken neck.
