

Mrs. Dills Dies At 90 In Franklin

**Pine Grove Resident
Was Jackson Native;
Rites Held 26th**

Mrs. Mary Louise Bennett Dills, widow of Thomas C. Dills, died January 24 at 2:45 p.m. at the home of a grandson, Vernon C. Pruett, in Franklin.

Ninety years old, she lived in the Pine Grove section and had been ill for about four weeks. She was a member of the Pine Grove Baptist Church.

Funeral services for Mrs. Dills, a native of Jackson County, were held the afternoon of the 26th at the Sugarfork Baptist Church by the Rev. William K. Shields, pastor of the Pine Grove church. Burial was in the church cemetery.

Mrs. Dills was a daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Mont Bennett. Mr. Dills died in 1943.
