

# DEATH CLAIMS OSCAR DOBSON

**Prominent Farmer Passes  
Wednesday Afternoon  
At His Home**

Oscar L. Dobson, 50, farmer of the Cartoogechaye section, died at 1:30 o'clock Wednesday afternoon at his home.

Mr. Dobson's death was caused by pneumonia after an illness of 10 days. The attending physician said his temperature rose to 111 degrees a short time before his death.

The funeral services were held this (Thursday) afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Mt. Zion Methodist church on Cartoogechaye, of which Mr. Dobson was a member. The pastor, the Rev. J. C. Swain, officiated, assisted by the Rev. A. A. Angel, Methodist minister. Burial was in Mt. Zion cemetery.

Mr. Dobson was a son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Ben Dobson and was a native of Macon county.

Surviving are his widow, the former Miss Nora Mashburn; two daughters, Ethel Ann and Mary Elizabeth, the latter being ill with pneumonia at present; and three brothers, John, of Andrews, Ralph, of Detroit, and Will, of Cartoogechaye.
