

STRUCK BY CAR FATALLY HURT

Harve Donaldson Dies As Result of Accident Saturday

Harve Donaldson, 42, of Hiawassee, Ga., who was injured Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock, when struck by an automobile driven by Billy Wallace, died in Angel hospital Tuesday morning at 4:30, without regaining consciousness.

Mr. Donaldson suffered a fracture at the base of the skull and a broken left leg below the knee.

Young Wallace, 17, son of Mr. and Mrs. Ernest Wallace, of the Cartoogechaye community, was coming into town on highway 28 when he met Donaldson going up the highway. Donaldson stepped in front of the car and as young Wallace tried to swerve back to avoid hitting him, he stepped back in front of the car again. Witnesses who saw the accident said it was unavoidable. No charges have been placed Wallace.

Mr. Donaldson was doing construction work for the United States forest service. He was a member of the Ellijay Baptist church, and was a son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Jim Donaldson, of Ellijay.

Funeral services were held at the Asbury Methodist church at Otto Wednesday morning at 11 o'clock.

Surviving are his widow, the former Miss Doshia McFalls, of Jackson county, and three children, Sue Elizabeth, James Bell and Furman E.; one sister, Mrs. Minnie Plemmons, of Asheville, and two brothers, Thomas Donaldson, of Jackson county, and Clinton Donaldson, of Ellijay.
