

Mrs. Dowdle Dies Sunday At Her Home

Mrs. Laura McClure Dowdle, widow of John Harvey Dowdle, died Sunday, February 17, at her home on Franklin, Route 2 (Clark's Chapel community). She was 82 and had been ill or a year.

Funeral services were conducted the 19th at 2 p.m. at the Clark's Chapel Methodist Church, of which she was a member, by the Rev. Mark Rose. Burial was in the church cemetery with Lewis, Clarence, and Harvey Vanhook, James Rice, Harold McClure, and Woodrow Dowdle serving as pallbearers.
