

2 Held in Fatal Shooting of Negro

BRYSON CITY, Sept. 12.—Frank Shuler, 24, and his cousin, Noah Shuler, 19, both of Graham county, were bound over to the next term of Swain county superior court here Tuesday afternoon following a preliminary hearing in connection with charges preferred following the fatal shooting of P. E. Dunham, negro, of Macon, Ga., on Highway No. 10 near Almond September 6.

Frank Shuler, following his arrest, admitted firing the shot that killed the negro, Swain County Jailer John Calhoun said. Frank Shuler, at the preliminary hearing, was denied bond, but Noah Shuler was given the privilege of posting bond of \$3,000. Officers said they were informed that bond would be posted in Graham county.
